HIP JOINT INJECTION DIARY

A hip joint injection involves injecting medicine directly into the joint. These injections can diagnose the source of pain, as well as ease the pain.

Diagnostic: By placed numbing medicine into the joint, the amount of immediate pain relief you experience will help Dr. Stewart to confirm the hip joint as the primary source of your pain. If you are completely relieved of your pain while the hip joint is numb, it means this joint is likely the source of your pain.

Pain relief: Along with the numbing medicine, time-release Cortisone may also be injected into the joint to reduce inflammation, which in some patients can provide long-term pain relief.

After the procedure your hip will be numb for several hours. Please take the time to do some of the activities that caused you pain in the past. This will be very helpful to Dr. Stewart to review at your follow-up appointment. Record how painful these activities are at certain increments of time, using the same pain score of 0-10, with 0 being low and 10 for severe pain.
