Risk Factors for Deep Venous Thrombosis (DVT)

- 1. Personal or family history of DVT or PE
- 2. Cancer (diagnosis and/or treatment within the past 6 months)
- 3. Previous major surgery within the past 4 weeks
- 4. Blood clotting disorder (Factor V Leiden, Protein C deficiency, Protein S deficiency)
- 5. Use of birth control pills or hormone replacement therapy
- 6. Tobacco use
- 7. Inflammatory bowel disease (Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis)
- 8. Age >70
- 9. Obesity (BMI >40)
- 10. Diabetes
- 11. Congestive Heart Failure
- 12. Coronary Artery Disease

No risk factors for DVT- Treat with aspirin 325 mg once daily for DVT prophylaxis

Presence of 1 or more risk factors- Treat with Coumadin for DVT prophylaxis
