

## **Risk Factors for Deep Venous Thrombosis (DVT)**

1. Personal or family history of DVT or PE
2. Cancer (diagnosis and/or treatment within the past 6 months)
3. Previous major surgery within the past 4 weeks
4. Blood clotting disorder (Factor V Leiden, Protein C deficiency, Protein S deficiency)
5. Use of birth control pills or hormone replacement therapy
6. Tobacco use
7. Inflammatory bowel disease (Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis)
8. Age >70
9. Obesity (BMI >40)
10. Diabetes
11. Congestive Heart Failure
12. Coronary Artery Disease

No risk factors for DVT- Treat with aspirin 325 mg once daily for DVT prophylaxis

Presence of 1 or more risk factors- Treat with Coumadin for DVT prophylaxis
